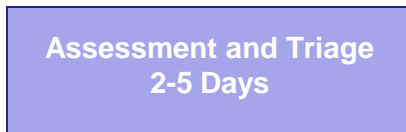




# HHS Integrated Stroke Model

Patient Groups (Impairment)	Patient Functional Level (Disability)
<b>Band 4:</b> Low Tolerance Long Duration •LOS – 60-180 Days	•Functional FIM<40 •Motor Function <37 •Elderly patients with a total FIM 40-60 •Long duration rehab
<b>Band 3:</b> Moderate-High Tolerance Short-Moderate Duration •LOS – 14-60 Days	• FIM functional score between 40-80 • FIM motor function between 38-62 • Patients demonstrate marked improvement but may be dependent in some areas at discharge
<b>Band 2:</b> High Tolerance Short Duration •LOS – 3-21 Days	•FIM Functional Score >80 •FIM motor function >62 •Outpatient rehab
<b>Stroke Prevention Clinic/ Acute Care / Inpatient Rehabilitation / Complex Continuing Care/Outpatient Rehabilitation</b>
